

## Bring your own device (BYOD) Class Guidelines

I understand that by bringing my own digital device I am agreeing to the following conditions:

- The device is only to be used at school for specific educational purposes ... texting, casual surfing, and checking in with social media (Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat etc) will result in BYOD privileges being revoked.
- Students with BYOD devices will not send any information from the school without a Teacher's permission.
- In order to protect all students' privacy, students are not to take any photos or videos without a Teacher's permission, and any posting of school photos/video on social media will result in the immediate suspension of digital privileges.
- BYOD are to be used only under the supervision of school staff - students are not to use them for entertainment outside of class times.
- Students are to turn all "Notifications" off on their devices while they are at school – pop-ups and vibration mode must also be off.
- Any technical support provided by any STAFF will be on a **goodwill** basis, and STAFF will not be held responsible for any resulting loss that occurs as a result of this technical support.
- The school is not responsible for any loss or damage associated with students bringing their own digital device - students do so at their own risk.
